The EFNS Academy for Young Neurologists 5th Course

After 4 successful courses of the above mentioned event in 2000 - 2003 the fifth run in 2004 will take place in hotel Bezdez, Lazensky Vrch 216, 471 63 Stare Splavy, tel.: +420 487 872 551, fax: +420 487 873 246. This site is situated in North Bohemia, about 90 km from Prague, on a shore of a romantic lake.

This traditional meeting developed from the previous workshops of European cooperation in neurology. As such it still preserves 2 major goals in its principle: Education in selected topics and discussions on the optimal organisation of neurological postgraduate education throughout Europe.

The educational part is divided into lectures of invited experts in the morning sessions and workshops in the afternoon. Participants are encouraged to prepare their own cases for demonstration and debates in the afternoon sessions.

In contrast to the previous years the principle of national representation by 4 participants will not be rigidly adhered to and thus also an individual application of colleagues is possible. Although applications of delegates by their National Neurological Societies should have preference, individual applications are welcome up to the full capacity of 120 participants.

Accommodation, tuition, board and programme are sponsored by the EFNS. Participants pay only their travel.

Participants arrive on Thursday, May 13th, the topics are scheduled for the 3 consecutive days. On May 17th half day discussions and half a day trip to Prague will be organized. On May 18th is only departure.
